The Program:

2016 VBS is scheduled for June 13-17! Children will climb aboard the "Vatican Express Bus" to uncover the Vatican treasures. They will explore St. Peter's Square, St. Peter's Basilica, and the Sistine Chapel. They will learn about the early Church and discover St. Peter, the first Pope.

As in all the Catholic Vacation Bible School programs we have used at Saint Agnes, a saint or saints is integrated throughout the learning experience because exposure to the saints as role models is wonderful for children. His job was to translate the Holy Bible into a language the people could understand. He did this monumental work with only the light of a lantern, using pen and ink. In this story, children will meet a wounded lion who was befriended by St. Jerome. The lion was wrongly accused of killing a gentle donkey under his care. A beautiful moral is found in this story concerning passing judgment without proof.

CHORALE & ORCHESTRA NOTES



Mass: Joseph Haydn, *Mariazellermesse* (1782) Offertory: W.A. Mozart, *Church Sonata in C*, K 336 (1780) "Mariazell" means "Mary in the cell," a reference to the cell

of Brother Magnus, a Benedictine monk who brought a limetree wood statue of Mary to the Austrian site in 1157, and founded a chapel there, which became Austria's national shrine to Our Lady. Joseph Haydn (1732-1809) composed the *Mariazellermesse* in 1782 probably for a society that fostered pilgrimages to the shrine. The fugues that close the *Gloria, Credo* and *Agnus Dei* are masterful examples of choral composition. The *Benedictus* uses the melody of the Austrian national hymn, *Gott Erhalte den Kaiser Franz* (God save Kaiser Franz) in a tender and touching manner. The Twin Cities Catholic Chorale is a non-profit corporation, which depends solely on the generosity of its patrons. Programs are posted at www.catholicchorale.org. Next Sunday the Chorale & Orchestra will present Charles Gounod's Saint Cecilia Mass.
