#### PASTOR'S COLUMN

#### 2016 Catholic Services Appeal: Why Should you Give?

Archbishop Bernard Hebda will be installed as our new Archbishop on the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, May 13, 2016. Later that evening, he arrived at Saint Agnes to pray before the Blessed Sacrament at our beautifully adorned Altar of Repose. Finally, he just accepted an invitation to the school this week to view the model churches constructed by our 8th grade students-even expressing a great interest in reading their papers written by the students about these beautiful representations of the California Missions.

I would like to echo his strong support of our parish and school by meeting our CSA goal in the next few weeks.

As is stated on their website, "The mission of the Catholic Services Appeal Foundation is to work with each of the parishes of the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis to conduct an Annual Appeal to fund 17 collective Catholic ministries within the Archdiocese that no one parish can support on its own."

Historically, Saint Agnes School has received more that \$100,000 in tuition aid from one of the ministries supported by the CSA. These monies are provided even though our parish goal is only \$45,895!

Mass: Charles Gounod, "Saint Cecilia Mass" (1855)

The music for this Mass is sponsored by Marlane Gallagher, Mary Lou Jantz, Charles Nelson, Ph.D., Brigitte Sandager, Virginia Schubert, Ph.D., Peter and Diane Welvang, B. Allen and Roger Young, and the Saint Anthony - Maria Hilf Council of Catholic United Financial in memory of Msgr. Richard J. Schuler

Composer Charles François Gounod (1818-1893) was a practicing Catholic and as a youth intended to become a priest. This Messe Solennelle was dedicated by the composer to Saint Cecilia, the patron saint of musicians, who like Saint Agnes was martyred for her faith in Rome and is memorialized in both the Roman Canon and the Roman Martyrology. The Gloria and Credo are famous for their drama, power and memorable melodies. The Sanctus with the enormous and beautiful tenor solo reaches a full musical climax at "Hosanna in excelsis" near the end of the movement. The Twin Cities Catholic Chorale is a non-profit corporation, which depends solely on the generosity of its patrons. Programs are posted on the Chorale web site at www.catholicchorale.org. Next Sunday the Chorale & Orchestra will present Franz Schubert's Mass in G.
