

#### PASTOR'S COLUMN

#### Saint Joseph the Worker

Although May is beautifully dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, the month begins with the Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker, May 1<sup>st</sup>. This year the feast fell on a Sunday and was superseded by the Sixth Sunday of Easter in the Ordinary Form, but I would like to take a little time to share a beautiful reflection on St. Joseph by Pope Benedict. The pope gave this reflection while on an apostolic visit to Africa in 2009. A parishioner very kindly forwarded this article to me from www.catholiconline.org.

"I ... encourage you to look to Saint Joseph. When Mary received the visit of the angel at the Annunciation, she was already betrothed to Joseph. In addressing Mary personally, the Lord already closely associates Joseph to the mystery of the Incarnation. Joseph agreed to be part of the great events which God was beginning to bring about in the womb of his spouse."

"He took Mary into his home. He welcomed the mystery that was in Mary and the mystery that was Mary herself. He loved her with great respect, which is the mark of all authentic love. Joseph teaches us that it is possible to love without possessing. In contemplating Joseph, all men and women can, by God's grace, come to experience healing from their emotional wounds, if only they embrace the plan that God has begun to bring about in those close to him, just as Joseph entered into the work of redemption through Mary and as a result of what God had already done in her."

"Joseph was caught up at every moment by the mystery of the Incarnation. Not only physically, but in his heart as well, Joseph reveals to us the secret of a humanity which dwells in the presence of mystery and is open to that mystery at every moment of everyday life. In Joseph, faith is not separated from action. His faith had a decisive effect on his actions. Paradoxically, it was by acting, by carrying out his responsibilities, that he stepped aside and left God free to act, placing no obstacles in his way. Joseph is a "just man" (Mt 1:19) because his existence is "ad-justed" to the word of God."

In imitation of Saint Joseph, let us never separate our faith from our actions, even our labor. In our work let us strive to be just, especially in the manner in which we deal with our customers, coworkers, employees and employers.

Saint Joseph the Worker, pray for us!

#### CHORALE & ORCHESTRA NOTES

Mass: W.A. Mozart, *Spatzenmesse*, K 220 (Premier) (1776) Offertory: W.A. Mozart, Church Sonata in C, K 328 (1779)

The music for this Mass is sponsored by Lois Berens, Mary Ann Heine, Mary Sherman Hill, Roger Huss, Charles Nelson, Ph.D., Virginia Schubert, Ph.D., and James Sieben in memory of Mother Mary Angelica of the Annunciation, founder of EWTN.

The Spatzenmesse (Sparrowmass) was composed in Salzburg by W. A. Mozart (1756-1791) in 1776. The Mass is sometimes termed a Missa brevis et solemnis, because it is short and simple in structure as a Missa brevis, but festively scored like a Missa solemnis. The nickname Sparrowmass is derived from violin figures in the Hosanna repeated after the Benedictus, which resemble birds chirping. Following the example of Joseph Haydn (such as in the Nicolaimesse), Mozart in this Mass recapitulates the music of the *Kyrie* in the Dona nobis pacem, something which Franz Xaver Süssmayr did in his completion of Mozart's Requiem. This is the debut performance of this Mass by the Chorale. The Twin Cities Catholic Chorale is a non-profit corporation, which depends solely on the generosity of its patrons. Programs are posted at www.catholicchorale.org. Next Sunday, Pentecost Sunday, the Chorale & Orchestra will present Ludwig van Beethoven's Mass in C.
