

The music for this Mass is sponsored by James and Dillon Kromhout in honor of the Kromhout Family Grandchildren

While seldom heard in concert halls and rarely recorded, this last complete Mass composed in 1780 by W. A. Mozart (1756-1791) nonetheless offers lovely, joyful music appropriate for liturgical use. The *Credo* is the second *Credo* Mozart composed for this Mass. He completed about two-thirds of the first *Credo*, up to *non erit finis*, and then put the piece aside. The celebrant today is Father Mark Pavlak who will be offering his First Mass of Thanksgiving.

The Twin Cities Catholic Chorale is a non-profit corporation, which depends solely on the generosity of its patrons. Programs are posted at www.catholicchorale.org. This Mass marks the end of the Chorale's 42nd season at Saint Agnes. The 43rd season begins on Sunday, October 9, 2016, when the Chorale & Orchestra will present Joseph Haydn's *Kleine Orgelsolomesse*.
