Preserving Beauty in Religious Articles

If you did not see it, one of our very own Saint Agnes parishioners was recently featured in a cover story in The Catholic Spirit. Sharon King regularly uses her time and talent to restore religious statuary and other goods. The article entitled, "Artist Restores Fatima Statue for Installation Mass," described Mrs. King's voluntary labor to painstakingly restore the statue of Our Lady of Fatima that was used during the Installation Mass of Archbishop Hebda on May 13, 2016 ~ the 99th Anniversary of the Fatima apparition in Portugal.



What you may not know is that Mrs. King, whose family have long been parishioners and whose children and some grandchildren are alumni of Saint Agnes School, has restored many beautiful statues and works of art at Saint Agnes. A sampling of her work on our campus includes:

• Restoration of countless crucifixes, including the one pictured, which hangs in my office.



• Restoration of the Saint Agnes statue in the flower garden outside of Schuler Hall.

• Repair of damaged Creche figures.

• Restoration of the entire set of Stations of the Cross in the Chapel.

• The statue of the Sacred Heart on the third floor of the school building.

• The statue of St. Bridget in the TLC Options office in the Convent (pictured to the right).

Many future generations will reap the benefits of having their minds and souls lifted to our Lord when they absorb the beauty of the statues that Mrs. King has repaired. We are very blessed to have her as part of our parish.
