#### PASTOR'S COLUMN

#### **Church Plaster Repair and Painting**

With the coming of summer, we have road construction all over the place in Minnesota and also our continued efforts to stay on top of all the work that needs to be done to maintain our beautiful church. By now, I am sure you have recognized all the scaffolding in the church. I am sorry for the lack of warning, but I did not expect the scaffolding to go up until the end of June. It is not my policy to complain when construction work is started ahead of schedule! Now that our church has been re-roofed, we can turn our attention to repairing and repainting the areas damaged by water leaks over the years. The scaffolding will be disassembled and re-assembled as the painters move from one area of the church to another. The funding, apart from the deductibles, is coming from Catholic Mutual Insurance Agency. At some point in the near future, we will fix some of the leaks associated with the bell landing of our beautiful steeple. Thank you for your patience and join me in praying for the safety of all the workers involved.

#### **Church Bathrooms**

At the time of writing this column we are scheduled to be finished with the remodeling of the bathrooms in the church basement! This is truly cause for singing a Te Deum! We have installed new plumbing, fixtures, lights, ceiling, stone tile for the walls and terrazzo for the floor. I am so grateful for the help of the facilities committee and the leadership provided by Diane Foote.

#### **Eucharistic Procession on Corpus Christi**

For the first time in living memory, we processed around the entire block following our Lord in the Most Holy Eucharist. The only benediction station on our pilgrimage route was in front of the new school addition. This was very fitting since the Ubel Activity Center was the first major building project for Saint Agnes in over four decades. Fr. Mark Pavlak sang his first Mass of Thanksgiving so beautifully and also did an admirable job bearing our Lord. May we always follow our Lord on our earthly pilgrimage and live out our Christian faith through Him, with Him and in our Eucharistic Lord.

Many thanks to all who helped make our Corpus Christi celebration so beautiful! I am also grateful for the Altar and Rosary Society hosting the reception for Fr. Pavlak after his Mass of Thanksgiving.
