PASTOR'S COLUMN

Coming this Fall - Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

"Do not be afraid to be saints. Follow Jesus Christ who is the source of freedom and light. Be open to the Lord so that He may lighten all your ways." Pope St. John Paul the Great Beginning this September, some of our youngest parishioners will have the opportunity to take part in a weekly religious education program called "The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd."

Many of you may have heard of this inspiring, hands-on program. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a Montessori-based Catholic program in which children can grow in their relationship with God through a deep engagement in Scripture and Liturgy.

CGS is based on the belief that God and the child are already in relationship, and that our work as adults is to provide a place for the child and God to come together and grow. In CGS, that place is called an "atrium." An atrium is a specially prepared room in which children can come to know Jesus, the Good Shepherd. The atrium is prepared with materials that children work with as a way of meditating upon the essentials of our Faith found in Scripture and Liturgy.

Examples of materials found in the atrium include small figures of Jesus and the disciples used to meditate on the Last Supper in the Cenacle; detailed, interactive maps of the Holy Land and Jerusalem to help situate Jesus as a real person in time; Jerusalem mustard seeds and beautiful pearls to help ponder the Parables of the Kingdom of God; and a small Baptismal font and Paschal candle used to explore the significance of Baptism. Our atrium will be housed in the basement of Saint Agnes Church and will be accessible via the doors for Schuler Hall.

The atrium is lead by a specially trained catechist. Our lead catechist is Mrs. Annamarie Adkins. She has many years of experience with The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program and is thrilled to be bringing it to the children of our parish.

Two sections of the Good Shepherd atrium will be offered each Wednesday beginning September 14 and running through May 4 with seasonal school breaks. Children must be 3-6 years old, potty trained and independent in the bathroom. Registration is currently open and will remain open through September 1. Early registration is encouraged for planning purposes. Please register via the Saint Agnes website by clicking on the "Catechesis of the Good Shepherd" option on the left-hand menu.

All are welcome to apply, but parishioners will be given a discount and priority placement. As the atrium sections are limited to 13 children each, it is first come, first served. The schedule and costs for the program are found on the registration page.

I am very grateful to Mrs. Adkins for bringing this program to our parish. I am hopeful that many of you will take advantage of it to enhance the catechesis of your families.


