TODAY AT SAINT AGNES

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I bring glad tidings of great joy!

Effective immediately, Father Andrew Jaspers has been assigned as a Parochial Vicar to the Church of Saint Agnes. His assignment to Saint Agnes (75%) is shared with St. John Vianney Seminary (25%) as a spiritual director. At Saint Agnes, we are privileged to have him teaching and providing pastoral ministry in our High School, as well as helping out on Sundays. He will also offer Mass in the Extraordinary Form for the Church of Saint Joseph in Miesville, MN twice per month on the second and fourth Sundays.

Fr. Jaspers was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of St. Paul/Minneapolis in May 2013. He is from Lake Crystal, MN. He is the son of Dr. Anthony and Mary Jaspers. After earning bachelor's and master's degrees in philosophy from Marquette University in Milwaukee and Fordham University in New York City, respectively, Fr. Jaspers taught at Creighton University in Omaha, where he also wrote philosophical articles for various Catholic publications before entering the seminary.

Below is the formal Decree from Archbishop Bernard Hebda regarding Fr. Jaspers' assignment to Saint Agnes. May I humbly request that everyone offer a prayer of thanksgiving to Saint Agnes for her heavenly aid and assistance of our parish in this assignment. Please join me in welcoming Fr.
