#### PASTOR'S COLUMN

Do not grow weary and lose heart"

I am often asked why after ten years of trying to become a Jesuit priest, I transferred to the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. I could point to the desire to be among fellow Vikings fans for the rest of my life, fleeing the territory of the home team of my old Wisconsin province. But that is only partially true.

From a this-worldly perspective, it is something of a failure to invest one's whole self in a project for ten years and not have it come to fruition. Many of us have comparable failures in our lives: broken marriages, wrongly interrupted careers, estranged children and relatives.

Our failures can demoralize us and expose us to the voice of the accuser, the Evil One, who interiorly berates us with the words: "It's your fault." The accuser sounds convincing because his words have the ring of truth. But this is because all lies are convincing only because they are partially true. The accuser is to be rejected not because the words are totally false, but because their motive is to discourage us and make us despair. This is the opposite of what the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete, wishes us to hear.

The Letter to the Hebrews tells us about Jesus this Sunday in the Ordinary Form: "Consider how he endured such opposition from sinners, in order that you may not grow weary and lose heart." Jesus' public ministry was one of increasing opposition and failure from a this-worldly perspective. But he saved us in this way to show us that the meaning of life is not found in success, but in faithfully trying to do the Lord's will. We may try and fail in many of these projects, and that is fine, because we are only called *to try*.

A vocation to priesthood, consecrated life, or marriage is always mutual: one can only try, and then one is left to be accepted or rejected by the one to whom one is proposing—the bishop, the religious superior, or the prospective spouse. And when one pursues priesthood, consecrated life, or marriage, one has to be prepared for divisions and suffering, especially when one is following God's will.

My years in the Jesuits were ones of great joys and great sufferings. Ultimately, through prayer and advice from my spiritual advisor, God showed me that I could attain greater holiness and help more people as a diocesan priest. Failing to become a Jesuit priest was a considerable suffering for me. But if you suffer in the Lord, and relate your sufferings to him, there can be lightness and joy in failure. The Lord shows us many things about ourselves, and helps us grow through our failures. His suffering shows us how suffering should be endured, and how it can open us to humility and love in ways that we did not know that we were capable of.


