### Confirmation at the Church of Saint Agnes

Children in our Archdiocese may be confirmed as early as their. 8th grade year. This is also our tradition at Saint Agnes.

#### Confirmation in the Ordinary Form for Saint Agnes is scheduled for Sunday, February 19 at 2:00 pm.

Your child will fit into one of three categories, each of which has its own requirements for preparation for Confirmation. Highlevel requirements for each category are listed below. A much more detailed document is found on our parish website. Please consult that document for more details.

Please note that Confirmation in the Extraordinary Form is not scheduled by Saint Agnes, but by the Archdiocese. In the past, dates for EF Confirmation were announced that resulted in a shortened timeframe for preparation. Therefore, if you know that you desire to have your child confirmed in the Extraordinary Form, please ensure that you understand the requirements for preparation that they must complete before they are allowed to receive the Sacrament.

Parents are the primary teachers of the Catholic Faith to their children regardless of whether the children are homeschooled, enrolled in Family Catechesis or students at Saint Agnes School. It is essential that parents exemplify and re-enforce the Catholic Faith in their homes.
