PASTOR'S COLUMN

Scrape and Paint—A Success Despite the Rain-Out



Last Saturday, August 27, over a dozen from the parish gathered to scrape, sand and paint the wrought iron fence in front of our beautiful church façade. Over an hour and a half into this stewardship event, the heavens opened up and we needed to stop working due to rain; fortunately, we had just finished the majority of the needed prep work.

I am grateful to all who sacrificed a Saturday morning to help us take care of our classic fence.

We have chosen another date to complete the work, **Saturday, September 10 starting at 9:00 am** as well as a back up date in case of rain (Saturday, September 17). **All are welcome to assist.** Please consider donating some of your time as well as bringing wire brushes and coarse sandpaper, in case there is some final prep work to do. (Power tools are always helpful!) The church will provide many brushes and paint buckets but extras are always helpful. Kneepads are also needed.

Novena to Our Mother of Perpetual Help—Now Starting at 7:00 PM on Tuesday Evenings

For over 70 years Saint Agnes Church has been honoring our Blessed Mother and asking for her intercession by praying the Novena to Our Mother of Perpetual Help every week.

In order to encourage more of the faithful to avail themselves of this aid to sanctification, I have moved the Novena to 7:00 pm and reinstated **confessions** after Novena **every** Tuesday starting at 7:30 pm. Also, following Novena and during confessions we will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet and the Holy Rosary. Thus, these devotions will be concluded in the same timeframe as is the past.

Once of the reasons for this change is that it has been difficult for members of the Twin Cities Catholic Chorale to participate in Novena before their weekly rehearsals. This time change will now afford this spiritually opportunity to our wonderful TCCC members. Furthermore, offering confessions every week on Tuesdays is a return to a long time tradition in the parish; Fr. Jaspers being assigned to our parish helps make this possible.
