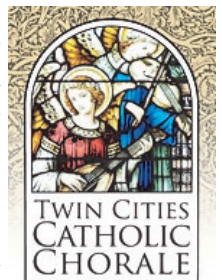

## CHORALE AND ORCHESTRA NOTES

Joseph Haydn, *Theresienmesse* (1799)

The *Theresienmesse* was composed by Joseph Haydn (1732-1809) in the summer of 1799. It is one of a series of six Masses requested annually by his patron, Prince Nikolaus II Esterhazy to celebrate the name-day of Nikolaus' wife, Princess Maria Hermenegild (1768-1845), and to be presented at the Prince's chapel in Eisenstadt.
